Request:

Everest Fastpitch is requesting authorization to build a 20' X 20' storage shed near the Varsity Field on the DC Everest school Grounds.

Purpose:

The shed will be utilized as a storage shed for both the school teams along with items for the Summer League of Everest Fastpitch. This will also allow us to expand our concession stand that is part of our current storage area. The new storage area will be centrally located between the Varsity and JV Field.

Location:

I have enclosed a sketch of the proposed location of the shed. We want it to be just outside of right field on the Varsity Field. Next to the current batting cage. This will be in a position that it will not block any view of the fields. It will require cutting down 1 tree. The trees' roots are now starting to grow under the concrete in our batting cage and will eventually start to damage the concrete base. It is also starting to grow out that it will continually need to be trimmed to stay clear of the Adventures Educations rope courses zip line.

Funding:

Everest Fastpitch has raised all funds needed to complete this project. We will need no additional funding from the school district. Everest Fastpitch will also be responsible for the maintenance of the shed.
