Education for Employment Plan Synopsis

PI 26.01 Applicability and Purpose

Under s. 121.02 (1) (m), Stats., every board shall provide access to an education for employment program approved by the state superintendent. The purpose of education for employment programs is to prepare elementary and secondary pupils for future employment; to ensure technological literacy; to promote lifelong learning; to promote good citizenship; to promote cooperation among business, industry, labor, postsecondary schools, and public schools; and to establish a role for public schools in the economic development of Wisconsin.

The attached Education for Employment plan highlights the programs currently in place that prepare students for life beyond high school. The plan also projects future projects and professional development needs that will enhance the district's education for employment program.

Listed below is a list of initiatives that will be implemented in the next five years:

- Implement Career Cluster's and Pathways for a seamless PK-16 career path
- Increase post-secondary transcribed credit offerings
- Educate staff on 21st Century Skills as well as Civic, Financial, and Entrepreneurial Literacy and Global Awareness having teachers implement these initiatives in their curriculum, instruction and assessment
- Create a high school Course and Career Guide to replace the current course book
- Create a junior high Course and Career Guide to replace the current course book
- School counselors will continue their training in the Wisconsin Comprehensive School Counseling Model bringing forth new post-secondary education and career planning initiatives
- Continue to support and improve work-based learning opportunities for all students
- Enhance collaboration between all related stakeholders
