- Update on WEAC's *Speak Out for Wisconsin Public Schools* event at the Middle School on October 12.
- Six D.C. Everest Senior High students competed in the 4th Annual Finance & Investment Challenge Bowl taking first place and will be going on to the state level. It is the third year DCE has taken first place.
- The 2011 yearbook staff won the All-KEMPA award at the fall journalism conference at UW-Whitewater. This is the first time the yearbook has received this top honor.
