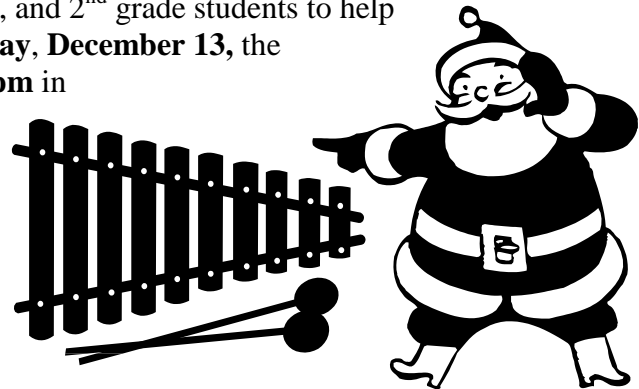

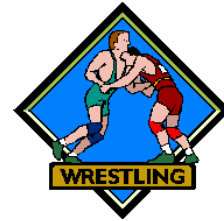

❄️ EVERGREEN VOLUNTEER HONORED ❄️



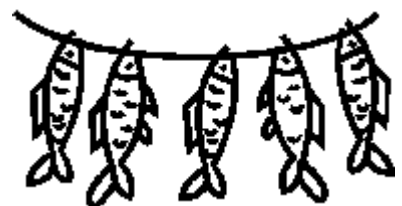
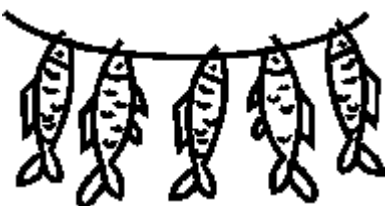
