

### **SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR AT ROTHSCHILD SCHOOL**

Many times, materials and supplies that are brought to school are not useful. In general, students only need basic school supplies. Students in the upper grades will need additional items that are not required for a student in the primary grades. We hope the following will help you. Individual teachers may have a few additional items, which you will be informed of in the fall. Please label these materials as your own. Also, be prepared to replace any of these items when they become unusable or lost.

#### **KINDERGARTEN: \*\*BE SURE TO LABEL ALL SUPPLIES\*\***

1. two (2) boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
2. schoolbag or backpack (large enough to put folders in)
3. one (1) large box of Kleenex
4. two (2) 8 oz. bottles of School Glue (not Glue-All)—Elmer's seems to work best
5. eight (8) glue sticks
6. eight (8) pocket folders--plain, non-shiny ones work best
7. plastic school box large enough for a box of crayons, bottle of glue, etc. (Mrs. Endrizzi and Mrs. Hazaert only)
8. 4-6 #2 pencils-- the plain yellow pencils are easiest to sharpen
9. old adult-size t-shirt for art---needs to fit easily over clothes, with name on front
10. activity/coloring book for independent use during indoor recess
11. plastic mat for rest time (Wal-Mart usually stocks these)
12. Last name A-L only--four (4) non-toxic dry erase markers to share
13. Last name M-Z only--a pack of 8-10 Crayola fine line markers to share
14. extra set of clothes, including socks and underwear **in a baggie**

#### **FIRST GRADE: \*\*BE SURE TO LABEL ALL SUPPLIES\*\***

1. one (1) bottle of **white** school glue (no colored or gel)
2. eight (8) glue sticks
3. two (2) boxes of 24 count crayons
4. 24 wooden yellow #2 pencils
5. one (1) small school box for supplies (approximately 5"x8")
6. total of five (5) plain folders: one (1) red folder, one (1) yellow folder, one (1) blue folder, one (1) purple folder, one (1) green folder **\*\* No binding inside and no decorative folders, please**
7. one (1) wide-lined spiral notebook
8. one (1) composition notebook
9. one (1) 3-ring binder (1/2 inch ring)
10. one (1) package of colored pencils (12 count)
11. **BOYS ONLY:** one (1) package of regular markers (8 or 10 count)
12. **GIRLS ONLY:** one (1) package of skinny markers (8 or 10 count)
13. one (1) large box of Kleenex for classroom use
14. old shirt for art (no plastic smocks)
15. activity book or coloring book for indoor recess

#### **SECOND GRADE: \*\*BE SURE TO LABEL ALL SUPPLIES\*\***

1. two (2) white school glue (Mrs. Maciaz only) and two (2) large glue sticks (Mrs. Radtke-Baur and Mrs. Wood only)
2. one (1) box of crayons (no more than 24)
3. twenty-four (24) #2 yellow pencils (put name on the side)
4. school box (cigar box type) please, no giant size boxes, but large enough to hold supplies
5. 2-pocket folders, solid colors only (with bottom pockets - no paper fastener strip in the middle) one (1) of each of the following colors: blue, red, yellow, green – no trapper keepers, please!
6. one (1) red marking pencil
7. backpack - large enough for folders
8. old tee-shirt (adult size) for art smock (no plastic smocks, please)
9. one (1) large box of Kleenex (for classroom use)
10. two (2) wide-lined spiral notebooks
11. four (4) dry erase markers
12. an old, clean sock
13. two (2) boxes of 10-12 colored pencils – basic colors only
14. 1" white ring binder with clear overlay on front (for Mrs. Wood only)
15. two (2) pink erasers (for Mrs. Radtke-Baur only)

**SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR 2009-2010 (CONTINUED)**

**THIRD GRADE: \*\*BE SURE TO LABEL ALL SUPPLIES\*\***

1. four (4) pocket folders of different colors (labeled with student's name)
2. three (3) packs of sharpened #2 pencils (**no** mechanical pencils)
3. pink erasers (2)
4. white glue stick **AND** bottle of white Elmer's glue
5. small pencil box (5"x8" approximately)
6. art smock (an old tee-shirt is fine)
7. colored pencils
8. one (1) large box of Kleenex for classroom use
9. 12" ruler (centimeters and inches)
10. four (4) red marking pencils
11. two (2) designer folders for take home
12. four (4) wide-lined notebooks (labeled with student's name)
13. 24 count box of crayons
14. one (1) small pencil sharpener
15. backpack

**FOURTH GRADE**

1. five (5) pocket folders
2. two (2) dozen #2 wood pencils
3. erasers
4. colored pencils
5. crayons
6. red marking pen
7. highlighter
8. ruler
9. glue
10. art smock (an old tee-shirt is fine)
11. one (1) box of Kleenex

**FIFTH GRADE**

1. two (2) red notebooks with folders to match
2. two (2) blue notebooks with folders to match
3. two (2) green notebooks with folders to match
4. four (4) notebooks any color of your choice with folders to match
5. #2 pencils (wood, please)
6. red and blue pens
7. crayons (no colored pencils, please)
8. one (1) box of Kleenex
9. ruler, glue/glue stick
10. 1" three-ring binder with pockets for assignment notebooks
11. three subject notebook
12. art smock
